## From the Theologian's Almanac (SALT)

March 23 is the day in 1942 when the U.S. government began forcibly relocating Japanese Americans from their homes on the West Coast to internment camps. Approximately 120,000 people were detained in this way, even as some Japanese-American men were drafted into the war effort. The camps remained operational for three years. In 1981, the Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians concluded that the internment was a "grave injustice" resulting from "race prejudice, war hysteria, and a failure of political leadership." President Reagan offered survivors an apology and \$20,000 each in 1988.

## **GRANTS TO IMPROVE ACCESSIBILITY OF CHURCH BUILDINGS**

At a recent meeting of the Granting and Enabling Leadership Team, the topic of handicapped access to church buildings was discussed. Several churches have received federal government grants of up to \$100,000 to improve the accessibility of their building. Eligible renovations include ramps, accessible doors, accessible washrooms, and elevators. Other potential funding sources include the Modernization and Improvement Grant (United Church of Canada Foundation) - a \$5000 matching grant for eligible congregations; and loans (not grants) can also be arranged through the Finance & Extension Board.


