DEEP SPIRITUALITY - BOLD DISCIPLESHIP - DARING JUSTICE



Deep Spirituality: All Saints' Day, the Golden Rule and a Grace-Filled Life (SALT) – edited for length

For those celebrating this Sunday as All Saints' Day, the lectionary's Gospel reading is from Luke's version of Jesus' most famous sermon, often called the "Sermon on the Plain." Jesus opens with declarations of blessing (for the poor, hungry, sad, and outcast) and woe (for the rich, well fed, happy, and admired), and then pivots toward instruction on living a graceful and gracefilled human life...This passage concludes with what is arguably Jesus' most

well-known teaching, the so-called "Golden Rule:" "Do to others as you would have them do to you" (Luke 6:31)... Jesus goes on to put it this way: "love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return" (Luke 6:35). This last idea, "expecting nothing in return," is the key ...And what do we call this kind of love, this completely free, above-and-beyond, gratuitous giving? We call it "grace."... with the Spirit's help, grace is bubbling up all around us all the time; if we stay alert, we'll notice it everywhere. All Saints' Day, indeed! Our everyday lives, full as they are of struggles...may also be full of love, full of mercy, full of grace.

The meeting will include presentations and table group discussions on spiritual practices, an opportunity to celebrate Executive Minister Rev. Rosemary Lambie's retirement and covenanting with our LLWLs (licensed lay worship leaders). The

presentation and discussion of the proposed regional council budget for 2023 will also be an important part of the business at this meeting; an advance learning session on **November 8** will give an opportunity to learn more and ask questions about the budget process (details below). At the national Congregational Support Ministers online meeting on October 20, there was a conversation about ActivateSpace https://activatespace.io/, an initiative which has received United Church Foundation funding in order to help support communities of faith seeking to maximise use of their buildings and reclaim their status as community hubs. Broadview magazine highlighted this initiative and its founder, Jordana Wright, in an interview published in April 2021, provocatively tagged: "9,000 faith properties could close soon. Jordana Wright has an idea to save them."
